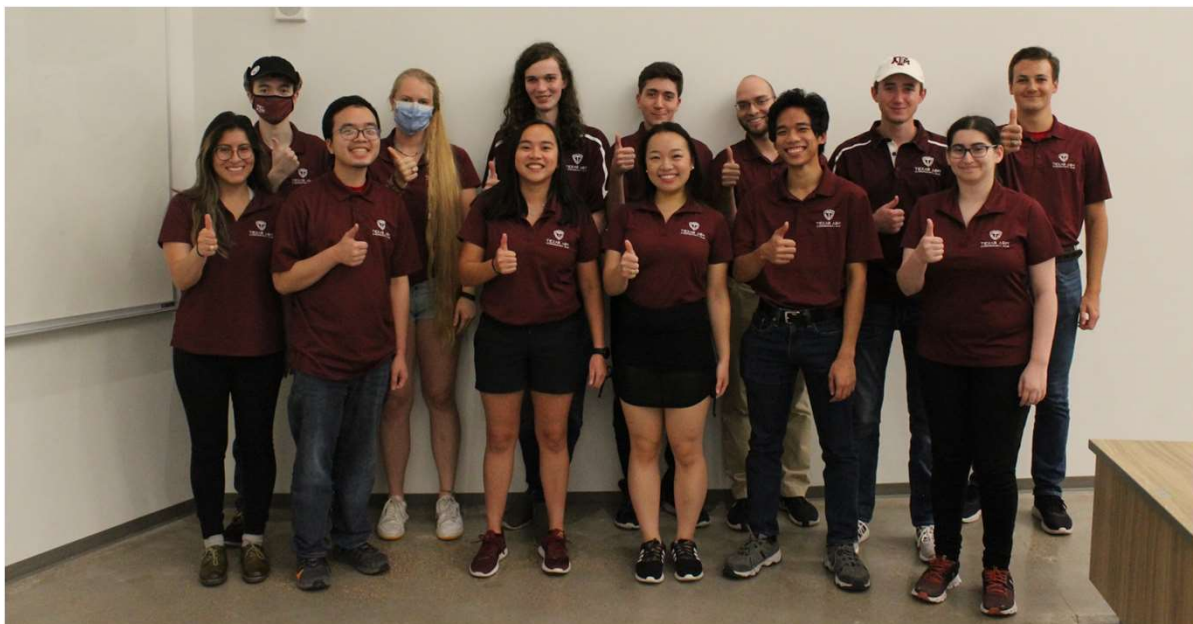


Synopsis

Club Structure

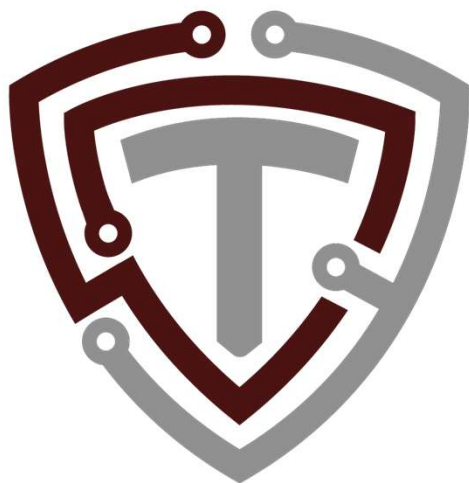
